### **WORKING WITH CHILDREN POLICY**

1. All current Colac & District Cricket Association (CDCA) Board Members must have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website
2. All current Colac & District Cricket Association (CDCA) Junior Committee Members must have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website
3. All current Colac & District Cricket Association (CDCA) Female Cricket Committee Members must have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website
4. All current Colac & District Cricket Association (CDCA) Umpire Members must have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website
5. All current CDCA Clubs Executive must have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website (President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer)
6. All current CDCA Senior sides must have at least 2 players from each side with a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website
7. All current CDCA Junior sides must have at least 4 Working with Children Checks (WWCC) per side (This must include all Coaches and Assistant Coaches) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website (Note Re Juniors a Senior Player or Club Executive/Official can be one of the four)
8. All current CDCA Representative (Junior, Senior and Female) Coaches and Assistant Coaches must have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website
9. All CDCA Representative Coaches and Assistant Coaches must have a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) which will be displayed on the CDCA Website
10. All CDCA Junior and Assistant Junior Coaches will not have any CLOSED Social Media Groups unless they have written permission from all parents as well as the CDCA Board of Management.
11. All CDCA Senior Club or Representative sides that at any point have a junior in a Social Media Group MUST have parental permission of the said junior to be included in the said Social Media Group.
12. Penalties for non-adherence to this policy will be determined and administered by the CDCA Board of Management.
